Allianz and its appointed service providers collect personal information (including sensitive information) about you including from third parties who assist Allianz in assessing your claim, including your employer.

Allianz may use your personal information for the purpose of assessing, processing, settling and managing your workers compensation claim, verifying any evidence submitted in support of the claim, resolving any claim disputes and managing your Return to Work program.

Allianz may disclose your personal information, inclusive of sensitive information, to your employer, other insurers, medical practitioners, rehabilitation providers, investigators, legal practitioners and other experts or consultants for the purposes above. Your personal information, inclusive of sensitive information, may also be disclosed as required or permitted by law. Allianz may disclose your personal details to WorkCover TAS which is authorised to use this information to fulfil its functions and obligations under the workers compensation legislation.

Your personal and sensitive information may be disclosed to entities located overseas, including other companies in the Allianz Group, business partners, reinsurers and others who assist us in providing our services. The countries to which this information may be disclosed will vary from time to time, but may include Canada, Germany, New Zealand, United Kingdom and the United States of America.

Collection of this information is required by the Workers' Compensation and Injury Management Act 1981. If any part or all of this information is not provided then your claim may not be accepted or processed.
